Instructions for Abstract Submission

We invite abstracts on topics related to (1) applications of next-generation sequencing in clinical settings, (2) current approaches, technological advances and challenges in genetic testing, (3) genetic and genomic education, and (4) challenges faced in the types of tests to order, diagnostic interpretation, genetic counselling and clinical care in the practice of genomic medicine. There are two tracks for abstract submissions: clinical track or biomedical research track. For clinical track, please indicate if you wish to give a case presentation under the Diagnosed/Undiagnosed Sessions. Please indicate when registering if you would like to submit an abstract for an oral or poster presentation.

Guidelines for Submission

- Completed abstracts can be uploaded with the online registration or can be emailed to secretariat.meeting2018@gmail.com
- Abstracts should be written in Microsoft Word with an A5 page size
- Margins: top and bottom - 2cm, left - 3cm, right - 1.5cm
- Abstracts should be written in the Times New Roman font
- The title of the abstracts must be capitalised, in bold
- All words in the abstract must use font size 11
- Single line spacing
- The author name list should appear after the title, with the presenting author's name placed first on the list, and in bold. This is followed by the author's affiliations.
- The abstracts may not exceed 220 words (excluding title, authors, and affiliations) and no reference should be cited.
- Abstracts can follow any style except for those for case presentations. Such abstracts should follow the CARE Check-list (<http://www.care-statement.org/resources/checklist>) with emphasis on:
 - i. The title of the case presentation should not give away the diagnosis
 - ii. Abstract should show up to 3 key learning points (for KNOWN) or 3 possible differential diagnosis/causative genes (for UNKNOWN)

Abstracts not accepted for oral presentation will be considered for poster presentation, subject to the author's agreement.
